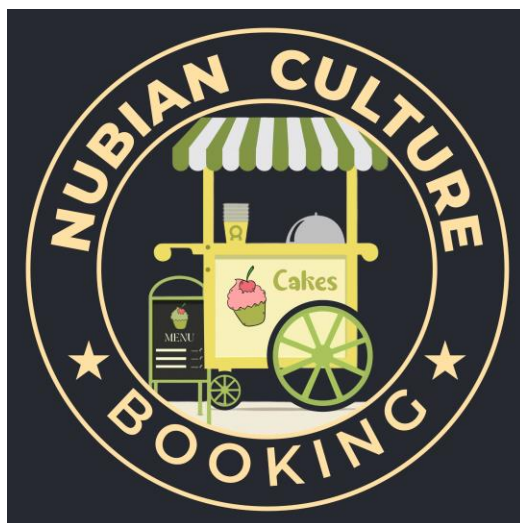




NUBIAN CULTURE BOOKING – Frequently Asked *Questions*(FAQ)
For Stallholders Hiring a Pitch at Our Local Market

1. How do I apply for a market pitch?

You can apply online or download and complete our Stallholder Application Form [here](#). Once filled out, email it to nubianculturebooking@outlook.com or return it in person to Nubian culture staff who would be at the market.

2. What types of stalls are accepted at the market?

We welcome a wide range of stalls, including fresh produce, street food, handmade crafts, clothing, homeware, and more. All stalls must meet our market criteria and be approved prior to trading.

3. How much does it cost to rent a pitch?

Pitch fees vary based on size, location, and additional needs like electricity. Prices start from [insert base rate] per day. Full details are listed in the application form and on our pricing page.

4. Do I need my own equipment?

Yes. Stallholders must bring their own tables, covers, and any other necessary equipment. We can advise on recommended sizes and setup tips upon request.

5. Is Public Liability Insurance required?

Yes, all traders must have valid Public Liability Insurance (minimum £X million coverage). A copy must be submitted with your application.

6. Is electricity available?

Electricity can be provided at select pitches for an extra charge. Please indicate your requirements on the application form.

7. What are the setup and trading hours?
